China's foreign trade of agricultural products maintained the trend of expansion in the first four months of this year, with the total value up 9.7 per cent year on year to \$111.71 billion dollars, official data showed.

Breaking it down, exports of those products rose 6.4 per cent to \$31.74 billion, while imports went up 11.2 per cent to \$79.97 billion, according to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs.

The trade deficit hit \$48.23 billion in the January-April period, up 14.6 per cent year on year, the data revealed.
