

Biopolin pollination enhancer now available in Canada

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For use in berries, tree fruit, canola, and other crops, Biopolin is sprayed on the crops during bloom and enhances pollinator activity in the crop leading to more flower visits. As a result, farmers benefit from increased pollination and substantial increases in yield and quality.

“Enhancing the pollination process is our final opportunity to increase our yield potential as a fruit grower.
