Saudi Arabiaâ??s National Centre for Palms and Dates announced that Saudi exports of dates increased by 5.4 per cent in 2022 compared with 2021 to reach SR 1,280 billion.

According to the official statement, export went up by 121 per cent over the period spanning between 2016 and 2022, where the annual average of exports of Saudi dates over these seven years increased by 12 per cent.

The centre pointed out that the development of the palm sector has helped increase the spread of Saudi dates in the majority of global markets, with 116 countries importing it.

The centre noted that what has been achieved reflects the interest of the wise leadership in enhancing non-oil revenues and developing the work system for growing and improving palm production based on the Saudi Vision 2030, which has paid great attention to the palm sector and dates through its development and sustainability.
